# This is the Chancellor's Senior Survey (CSS) homepage, which is located on the Division of Management Information (DMI) website (https://secure.dmi.illinois.edu/SeniorSurvey/). #### The Chancellor's Senior Surveys on the Undergraduate Experience at UIUC

In 1989, a taskforce appointed by the Chancellor created a questionnaire to be administered to all graduating seniors at UIUC. The results of the survey, the Chancellor said, "will be useful in responding to requests for information on how our students feel about the educational experience they have had as undergraduates here and in identifying problems on campus which need our attention." The survey was administered each year from 1990 to 1993. Due to the consistency of results the survey was not administered again until 1996. The 1996 survey was modified to include a section of items asking students to assess their entering and exiting abilities. Due to the usefulness of this new section for campus initiatives involved in the assessment of student outcomes, the campus decided to restart annual administrations of the survey. The survey was offered through 2012. During the 2015-2016 academic year, a committee redesigned this long-standing survey to increase its effectiveness and usefulness. During the 2016-2017 academic year, the revised survey was administered for the first time.

Illinois Chancellor's Senior Survey Questionnaire

#### Senior Survey Dashboard Restricted to full-time faculty and staff.

The Senior Survey Dashboard provides an interactive way for faculty and staff to review the survey results, allowing for the units to look at results by college, department, international student status, gender, and race/ethnicity. #### Senior Survey Dashboard User Agreement

Due to the sensitive nature of data provided here, we begin with some guidelines...

Senior Survey has human subjects review and approval (protocol #17116). All use of data must be conducted within the protections and structures set within that documentation. As such, we ask you to review this user agreement, and indicate your acceptance and agreement on each item before proceeding to the other sections of the website.

1. The Senior Survey Dashboards are intended only for use by University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign campus, college, and department leadership.

Do not share your password or your account access with others.

2. The purpose of the Senior Survey Dashboards is to provide visualizations for the Senior Survey results that may be used to better understand and improve the student experience. This information may be used for program review, accreditation, program improvement and communication with key campus stakeholders.

All findings will be presented in aggregate. Data will only be provided when a minimum number of 10 survey responses are available in order to protect the confidentiality of survey respondents. You are welcome to filter the charts, hover over different chart elements to get more detail, but please note the response rates (number of respondents compared to number of graduates) for each of the chart elements. Be certain you are telling responsible stories with the data. If you need assistance interpreting your results, reach out to the Division of Management Information (dmi@illinois.edu). 
3. Data or information obtained via the Senior Survey Dashboards CANNOT be used for research purposes.

It is possible to use data and information from the Senior Survey Dashboards for research purposes; however, prior approval is required with an amendment to the Senior Survey IRB and review by the Office for the Protection of Research Subjects. Please note that our team is small and serves the entire campus. The number of research inquiries that we can handle is limited.

4. No individuals should respond to FOIA or similar direct requests from external sources using the data or information from the Senior Survey dashboards.



Response rates by gender, race/ethnicity.






